Majority of students will take. Regents exam.

## Regents Extended Courses (RE)

Double period every other day.

### Honors Courses (H)

More rigorous, faster pace, notated on transcript.

### Advanced Placement (AP)

More rigorous, faster pace, weighted grade

## Challenge By Choice

Departmental recommendation can be challenged.

### Prerequisite & Co-requisite

Previous course passed/Course taken concurrently.



## **SCHEDULING TIMELINE**

#### February 1st – 9th

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Parents will have access to the parent portal and the ability to view and change their child's elective classes until **February** 

#### 9th

\*After February 9th, contact your child's counselor with any scheduling concerns

February 1st - 9th

Counselors will be taking 8th grade students into the computer lab to view course placements and elective choices

#### March/April/ May

These months are devoted to building the master schedule based upon course placements, student requests, and fiscal constraints
